On January 2024, 7, two decades have passed since the beginning of a major reform journey in Moroccan contemporary history. Established in 2004, the Equity and Reconciliation Commission was a real milestone in a long process that has led and contributed to fundamental reform.

Morocco's truth commission, unprecedented at the regional level and one of the leading experiences and best practices at the continental and international levels, focused on the past with a forward-looking vision. The 20th anniversary events that will continue throughout 2024, do not only celebrate the establishment of the commission, but a whole process—a timeline of approximately 65 years. The Equity and Reconciliation Commission was mandated to investigate and establish the truth about serious human rights violations that occurred between the years 1956 and 1999.

It did not only inquire about the violations and seek to provide reparations for victims and right-holders, but also aimed at prompting the nation to own and preserve the past as a collective memory. The ultimate objective was drawing lessons from the past and using them as cornerstones for guaranteeing non-recurrence and building the future of a society aspiring to take off and foster a peaceful transition focused on democracy, human rights and sustainable development.

In addition to revisiting the past, we are celebrating the wills of both the State and society to shape the future, establish the truth and achieve equity and reconciliation. We will also be focusing, throughout this year, on subsequent processes and reform that have built upon each other, sparking true momentum in the last two decades as a positive and successful outcome with profound impact on reinforcing the rule of law, democracy and effective access to human rights. As a national human rights institution (NHRI), we have been deeply involved, every step of the way, in Morocco's leading transitional justice experience.

It was Morocco's NHRI that first issued a recommendation to establish both the Independent Arbitration Commission, tasked with providing reparations for the victims of enforced disappearance and arbitrary detention, and the Equity and Reconciliation Commission, a few years later. In addition to providing support and resources to the

IER, the NHRI was mandated to follow up on the implementation of the Commission's recommendations. The role of the NHRI in this process is by itself a cherished best practice in the actions of NHRIs, in particular, and in transitional justice experiences, in general.

Alongside a permanent exhibition for truth, equity and reconciliation at the main hall of its headquarters in Rabat, as well as a series of programs, films, meetings and intellectual, societal and civil activities to celebrate the 20th anniversary, the NHRI is bringing the celebrations to its Human Rights Pavilion at Morocco's International Book Fair (SIEL 2024).

We want to involve more people, visitors and passersby, and celebrate with them the lessons and successes of this experience, including the legislative and constitutional reform that it has contributed to. We also want to spark debate and exchange with intellectuals, writers, civil society members, readers, youth, students and children on new best practices, the prevention of human rights violations, the protection of human dignity, the fight against discrimination, etc.

Besides artistic expression, literature, publications, discussions with national and international experts on related themes and priorities, the human rights pavilion will address emerging threats and issues relating to human rights.

Since 2019, the human rights pavilion has consistently honored children as special guests at every edition of the fair. It is a tradition we have established with children from the twelve regions of Morocco. This year, they will lead similar discussions and sessions, and interact with experts and visitors to make their voices heard.

I look forward to meeting each and every one of you and welcoming you to the human rights pavilion at the 29th International Book Fair.

Join us to celebrate the 20th anniversary of truth, equity and reconciliation at the book fair.

Nous avons célébré, le 7 janvier 2024, le vingtième anniversaire de l'Instance Équité et Réconciliation (IER): une étape charnière dans l'Histoire moderne du Maroc. Créée en 2004, l'IER a marqué un long processus qui a culminé en une réforme fondamentale dans le pays.

Appuyée par une vision avant-gardiste et prospective, l'IER a réussi à rallier le passé, le présent et le futur, et constituer une expérience inédite non seulement à l'échelle régionale, mais également à l'échelle continentale et internationale. Cette année, nous ne commémorons pas seulement l'anniversaire de l'IER, mais également l'ensemble d'un processus s'étalant sur plus de 65 ans.

Le mandat de l'IER consistait à établir la vérité sur les violations graves des droits de l'Homme intervenues au Maroc entre 1956 et 1999. L'Instance n'a pas seulement mené des investigations sur ces violations et assuré la réparation due aux victimes et aux ayants droits, mais a également œuvré à la collecte et à la préservation de la mémoire collective de la nation, l'objectif ultime étant de tirer des enseignements du passé en tant qu'élément central de la quête commune pour édifier un avenir meilleur et réussir une transition pacifique vers la démocratie, les droits de l'Homme et le développement.

Cette année, nous évoquons un long passé et nous célébrons la convergence entre la volonté de l'Etat et celle de la société qui s'est manifestée dans une quête commune visant à révéler la vérité, à rendre justice, à réconcilier et à construire l'avenir. Nous nous concentrerons également, tout au long de l'année 2024, sur les processus et réformes qui en ont découlé, insufflant un véritable élan au cours des deux dernières décennies avec un impact profond sur le renforcement de l'Etat de droit, de la démocratie et de l'effectivité des droits de l'homme.

Le Conseil national des droits de l'Homme a joué un rôle central dans l'expérience de justice transitionnelle marocaine. Il avait recommandé la mise en place des deux mécanismes de justice transitionnelle (l'Instance indépendante d'arbitrage pour l'indemnisation des victimes de la disparition forcée et de la détention arbitraire, et par la suite l'Instance Équité et Réconciliation). L'institution a apporté son soutien à l'IER et a été mandatée pour

suivre la mise en œuvre des recommandations en matière de vérité, d'équité et de réconciliation. Il s'agit d'une initiative inédite et d'une bonne pratique mettant en relief les rôles des Institutions nationales des droits de l'Homme en matière de justice transitionnelle et en matière des processus qui y sont liés.

En plus d'une exposition permanente au siège du CNDH à Rabat dédiée à la commémoration du vingtième anniversaire de l'IER, nous proposons un programme diversifié d'activités (rencontres culturelles, séminaires et débats...) et nous avons décidé de faire de cette commémoration un thème principal du stand du CNDH au Salon International de l'Édition et du Livre (SIEL). Nous espérons, dans ce cadre, impliquer les visiteurs du salon dans cette commémoration et les sensibiliser aux principales réformes législatives et constitutionnelles réalisées. Nous visons aussi à stimuler la réflexion, le débat et le partage avec des écrivains, des experts, des acteurs de la société civile, des jeunes, des étudiants et des enfants, sur les nouvelles bonnes pratiques, la prévention des violations des droits de l'Homme, le respect de la dignité, la lutte contre la discrimination, etc.

L'espace du Conseil national des droits de l'Homme abritera diverses activités (débats, rencontres littéraires, activités artistiques avec les enfants) et proposera des échanges avec des créateurs et des experts nationaux et internationaux. L'espace abordera des questions et des défis actuels et émergents s'inscrivant dans l'agenda des droits de l'Homme.
